**Community Updates since November meeting**

- 5-2-1-0- Rated all the proposals of the \$28k - Ranked them with the criteria - sustainability feasibility.
  - No flashing beacon - they wanted to fund the whole project, not part of it.
  - Signs got a 4.2 rating! Total cost - around \$2500
  - Region 6 will look at proposals and then they'll recommend and it will go to IDPH and they will approve or disapprove of the plan.
- Trail signs - The rating sounds promising
- Crosswalks - no report (Plans were supposed to be done today)
- Tama/Toledo are sending in a joint project to the Mansfield foundation - Jill is submitting 2 projects
  - A trail along the west side of Oak Park (Tama Park by pool) all the way and handicapped parking.
  - Pool - Looking at putting in a pergola to provide shade
- Jill talked to the city engineer - they have completed the Teep study to do the crosswalk by the HS - so we can apply for money from the DOT for the flashing beacon. He's going to provide options.
