## Minutes of the Tama-Toledo Healthy Hometown Steering Committee January 4, 2024 Tama Civic Center

Karen showed the **video** made by Jeff Jensen of Trees Forever that was used to introduce Tama-Toledo during the Iowa Living Roadway Conference in Ames on November 2<sup>nd</sup>. Mark posted it on the cv.tamatoledo.org website. We discussed ways to use this video to inform the community of our goals and to get more support of projects. Mark will work on making it a preshow at the Wieting for an adult movie maybe one weekend a month. Karen gave an update on the **Highway 63** Crossing in front of the high school. Our DOT Rep, Gage, said the award announcements would be made in early March. The Tama City Council is including their expense of \$42,000 in this year's budget to cover their share if we receive the award. Our committee will help find other supporters to share this cost. Some possibles are the STC School Board and Iowa Premium.

A discussion was held on how we could support the **Rec** Committee. It was decided to ask to be put on their agenda, so we could show the video and help inform their members of our goals. Karen will contact Chelsea Arends the current president. Their website is stc.tamatoledo,org
